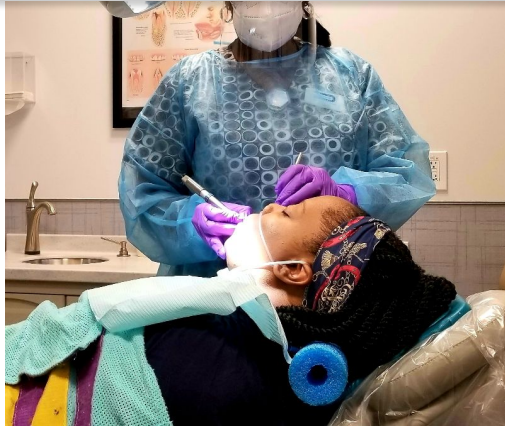

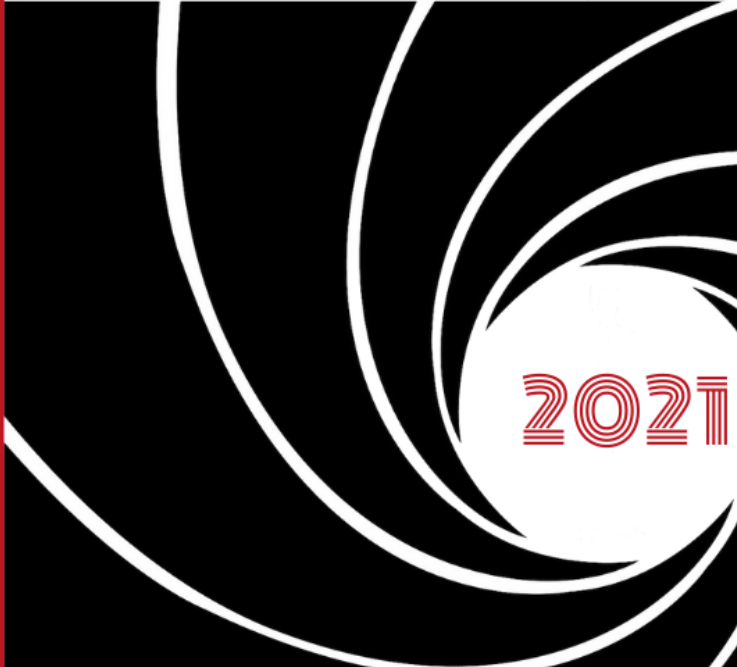

- On Friday, January 15, 2021, Governor Kemp signed an emergency Executive Order 01.15.21.01 authorizing Dentists in the state of Georgia to administer the COVID-19 vaccine.
